



Selection Policy

1. Objective

The objective of this Selection Policy is to ensure the best possible squads, sides, teams, and players are selected to achieve maximum success when representing CBSRC.

All players with strong claims for selection will be considered by the CBSRC Selection Committee.

2. Selectors

The Selection Committee for the 2024/25 season is as follows:

3. Player Eligibility

To be eligible for selection in any CBSRC squad, team, or side, a player must:

- Be a financial bowling member of CBSRC.
 - Make themselves available for trial matches and training sessions as arranged by the selectors.
 - Sign and abide by the **CBSRC Code of Conduct**.

4. Player Selection Criteria

The following criteria will be considered during the selection process:

- **Performance:** Results in club championships, regional championships, and trial matches.
- **Team Spirit:** A willingness to be a team player and adherence to the CBSRC Code of Conduct.
- **Leadership and Compatibility:** Leadership qualities, team balance, and compatibility with other players.
- **Attitude and Cooperation:** Demonstrated or potential ability and attitude to work with selectors, side officials, and team members.

- **Behaviour Standards:** Maintaining high behavioural standards on and off the bowling green, with a commitment to uphold the club's reputation.
 - **Alcohol Policy:** Excessive consumption of alcohol before or during matches, as deemed by the selectors, will result in non-selection for subsequent matches.

5. Player Selection Procedure

1. The Selection Committee has full discretion in making selections and may consider any one or more of the selection criteria.
 2. If a consensus cannot be reached during the selection process the chairman will have the casting vote.
 3. The decision of the Selection Committee is final and no reason is required to be provided for any selection or other decision.
 4. A player disputing a selection must submit their dispute in writing to the Chairman within **48 hours** of the team announcement.
 - The Selection Committee will respond to the dispute within **7 days** of the submission.
 - No response will be provided after the **48-hour** dispute period has expired.
 5. At the discretion of the Selection Committee Chair, the Committee may consult or seek input during competition from individual players, the elected leadership group, or the side/team.
